Mitch Van Dewerker is the interim chief financial officer and vice president and controller for United Launch Alliance (ULA). In this role, he provides leadership to ULA's finance organization and oversees all fiscal and fiduciary responsibilities in addition to responsibility for accounting and tax, financial planning and analysis, overhead rates and budgets, cost policy, accounts payable and payroll, facilities and property management.
