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Tom Glaub is the vice president of Government and Enterprise Contracts & Estimating for Boeing. Glaub is responsible for leadership of domestic and international formulation, negotiation and administration of all government and Defense related international contractual agreements with external customers. He provides direction and oversight to enforce contract terms and conditions, delinquent cash collections and customer credit limits, government regulations, and company reputation, federal and local compliance across multiple regulatory areas.

Prior to this role, Glaub served as the Vice President of Contracts for Boeing Defense, Space & Security (BDS) and the Gov't portion of Boeing Global Services (BGS). Before joining the Contracts organization, Glaub was the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) for United Launch Alliance (ULA), where he led ULA's finance organization and oversaw all fiscal and fiduciary responsibilities. Glaub has also served as the CFO for the Vertical Lift division of BDS. In this role, Glaub was responsible for optimizing the financial performance of the company's portfolio of Cargo, Tiltrotor and Attack rotorcraft programs, in addition to overseeing site-wide business activities and transactions in Mesa and Philadelphia.

Glaub has more than 30 years of Boeing leadership experience including a previous role as CFO for Boeing Information Technology & Data Analytics (IT&DA), and CFO for the Weapons & Missile Systems portfolio within BDS. He has held leadership roles as senior business manager for Cruise Missile Systems, senior estimating and pricing manager for Global Services & Support, and manager of contracts & pricing for the F/A-18 program.

Glaub holds a Bachelor of Science degree in mechanical engineering from the University of Missouri at Columbia and a Master of Business Administration degree from St. Louis University.

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
